This year's course is called: **On the Third Day**. A brand new 5-session ecumenical course for discussion groups written by Bishop John Pritchard –



Rationale: The resurrection is the Big Story that turned a little Jewish protest movement into a world-transforming religion. However, by Easter Monday we've almost forgotten about it and are planning our summer holidays.

How can we re-capture the explosive power of the resurrection that ricocheted around the world?

How can we live in the glow of resurrection and be an Easter people?

How can 'there and then' become 'here and now'?

COULD YOU REPRESENT THE BENEFICE?

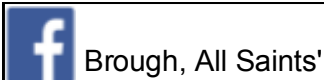
Hunsley Christian Youth Trust

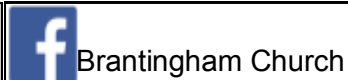
Hunsley Churches Together

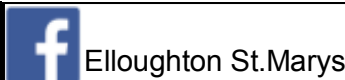

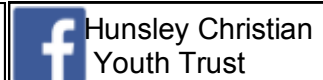
