-session ecumenical course for discussion groups written by
Bishop John Pritchard –

COULD YOU REPRESENT THE BENEFICE?

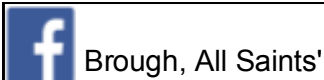
Hunsley Christian Youth Trust

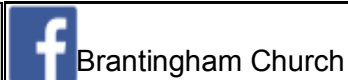
Hunsley Churches Together

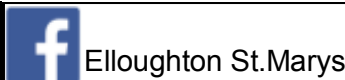

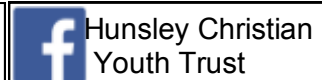
