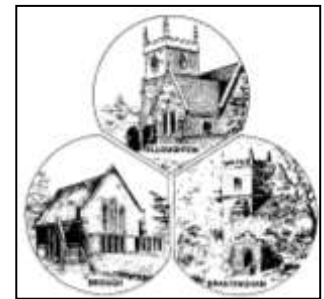

This year's course is called: **On the Third Day**. A brand new 5-session ecumenical course for discussion groups written by Bishop John Pritchard

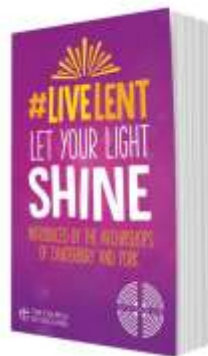
5 Session titles are:
