If you are interested you can have a chat with Pete to ask him about the work it involves. This is a paid post.

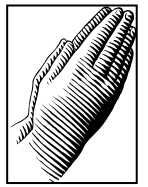

Editor's Note: The Rev. Billy Graham, who passed away on Wednesday, wrote this column before he died.

Q: Mr. Graham, how would you like to be remembered? – D.F.

A: I hope I will be remembered as someone who was faithful – faithful to God, faithful to the Gospel of Jesus Christ and faithful to the calling God gave me not only as an evangelist, but as a husband, father and friend.

I'm sure I've failed in many

ways, but I take comfort in Christ's promise of forgiveness, and I take comfort in God's ability to take even our most imperfect efforts and use them for His glory.

By the time you read this, I will be in heaven.

But I won't be in heaven because I've preached to crowds or because I've tried to live a good life. I'll be in heaven for one reason: Many years ago I put my faith and trust in Jesus Christ, who died on the cross to make our forgiveness possible and rose again from the dead to give us eternal life. Do you know you will go to heaven when you die? You can, by committing your life to Christ today.
