PARISH ANNUAL MEETINGS

Every year the Church of England [and Charities Commission] requires that we hold an annual meeting. This is required for each 'Parish'. Our Benefice is made up of two Parishes, Brantingham Parish and Elloughton cum Brough parish.

Each parish in fact has two meetings, the first is the Annual Parishioner's meeting, this is to elect the Churchwardens for each parish. You are eligible to vote at this meeting if you are on the parish electoral roll or live in the parish.

The second meeting is the Annual Parochial Church Meeting [APCM], at this meeting we receive the annual reports and elect Deanery Synod Representatives and Parochial Church Council [PCC] members. At this meeting you are only eligible to vote if you are on the electoral roll.

Anyone can be on the electoral roll if they live in the parish or have been attending church regularly over six months.

Please consider standing for Churchwarden or PCC and help to keep our churches fully functioning and having an active impact on our community.

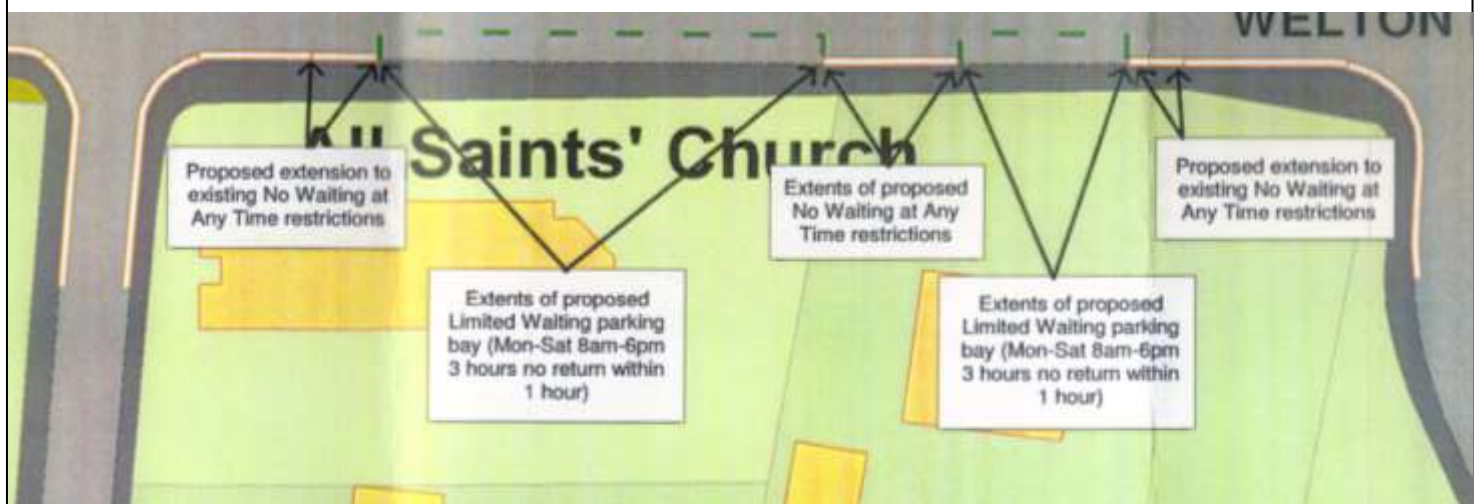
The annual meetings happen on a Sunday with the 'Parishioner's Meeting' taking place immediately after the morning service, this is then followed by the 'APCM'. There then follows a very brief meeting of the new PCC to elect the new officers: Secretary, Treasurer, Standing Committee, Finance Committee and vice chair of PCC.

Elloughton & Brough's annual meeting will take place following the 10.00am service on SUNDAY 8th APRIL. *[This will be the only service in the parish that day]*

Brantingham's annual meeting will take place following the 9.15am service on SUNDAY 15th APRIL

Please pray for all those who hold an office and serve our parishes.

Planning permission has been granted for parking restrictions outside All Saints' Church, Brough. This will limit parking, Monday-Saturday, to a maximum of 3 hours at any one time, which will stop people parking here before catching a train!

GDPR—Changes to the Data Protection Act

The Data Protection Act is being updated and comes into effect on the 25th May 2018. We are in the process of writing a Privacy Notice to outline how we comply with our obligations under the “GDPR” by keeping personal data up to date; by storing and destroying it securely; by not collecting or retaining excessive amounts of data; by protecting personal data from loss, misuse, unauthorised access and disclosure and by ensuring that appropriate technical measures are in place to protect personal data. This 'Policy Notice' will be available on our website shortly and there will be a hard copy in each church by the 25th May.

If you received the Pew News and/or the Pew Sheet by e-mail you will be receiving an e-mail in the next few weeks asking for your written consent for us to keep you on the mailing list. If we have not received your written consent by the 17th May 2018 you will be deleted from the mailing list and will no longer receive any e-mails from us. If you miss this date you can be added back to the list at any time by giving your written consent or you may also withdraw your consent whenever you wish and you will be deleted from the system.

To begin to comply with the regulations our monthly Register [above] can only record details of funerals undertaken by our Vicar or representative.
