# Hull Foodbank

Hull Foodbank are part of a nationwide network of foodbanks supported by the Trussell Trust who work to combat poverty and hunger across the UK.



Our local foodbank is based in Jubilee Church in central Hull.

The foodbank is there to help anyone who is facing hunger because of a crisis – for parents skipping meals so their children can eat, for the tenant forced to go hungry just to pay rent, for the elderly person making the stark choice between heating and eating.

They provide 3 days emergency food and practical support to help people to cope in a crisis, as well as to give advice and signpost to other services in the area, to help people recover, rebuild their lives and break the cycle of poverty.

They partner with a wide range of care professionals such as doctors, health visitors, social workers and police to identify people in crisis and issue them with a foodbank voucher.

Examples of items needed include tinned fruit, tinned vegetables, tinned meat and fish, teabags and coffee.

We have started a collection point in Brough Church which I will drop off on a regular basis. I will supply a poster of the items they need to all of the churches and I have also printed small lists which can be popped in your purse. All items need to be new and in date. If you would like to contribute any items I would be very grateful.
