Hull Foodbank



Hull Foodbank, based in Jubilee Church in central Hull, is there to help anyone who is facing hunger because of a crisis – for parents skipping meals so their children can eat, for the tenant forced to go hungry just to pay rent, for the elderly person making the stark choice between heating and eating.

They partner with a wide range of care professionals such as doctors, health visitors, social workers and police to identify people in crisis and issue them with a foodbank voucher.

Examples of items needed include tinned fruit, tinned vegetables, tinned meat and fish, teabags and coffee.
