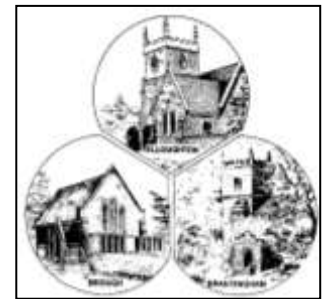

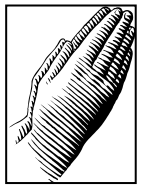

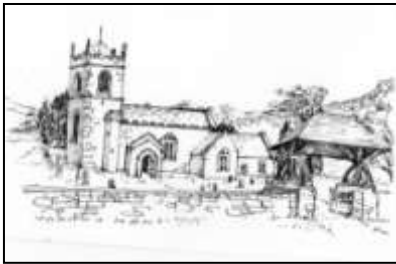

'Thy Kingdom Come' is a global prayer movement which invites Christians around the world to pray between Ascension and Pentecost for more people to come to know the transformational love of Jesus Christ. Our hope is that, as they pray, people will be empowered by the Holy Spirit, finding new confidence to be witnesses for Jesus Christ.

Thy Kingdom Come is a call to prayer.

How do we get involved? During this time we may:

- Remember Our Calling  
– to worship, to learning and caring, to service, and to evangelism.
- **Reflect** on the disciples waiting in faithful expectation between the ascension of Jesus and Pentecost for the outpouring of God's Spirit.
- **Respond** in prayer. Pray for five people you know, who don't know Jesus.

You may wish to organise a one-off prayer meeting with friends to commit individually or as a small group to daily prayer.
